Result of the radioactivity monitoring on wild wakame seaweed in Iwate Prefecture

The fishing season of wild wakame seaweed has started in Iwate Prefecture for the first time after the East Japan Earthquake.

Iwate Federation of Fisheries Cooperative Associations conducted sampling and radioactivity inspection of wild wakame seaweed at a private inspection facility prior to the start of fishing season.

The result is as follows.
