Results of Inspection on Radioactive Materials in Fishery Products

The Aomori Prefectural Government has conducted the inspection on radioactive materials in the Japanese flying squid sample landed at the Hachinohe Fishing Port on 1 August, 2011 as follows. The result of the inspection shows that radioactive materials were not detectable.
