

Results of inspection on radioactive materials in agricultural, animal and fishery products produced in Hiroshima Prefecture (5th report)

The Hiroshima Prefectural Government has conducted the inspections on radioactive materials in agricultural, animal and fishery products produced in Hiroshima Prefecture to prevent harmful rumors, to maintain prefecture's brand, and to secure the food safety of local products. The results of the inspections are as follows.

1. Result

The result of inspection for the oyster sample shows that both radioactive cesium and radioactive iodine were not detectable.
