Length: 87.0 meters

Schedule of calling at Honolulu Harbor:

○ Purpose of the voyage

Japan, as a responsible fishing country, recognizes the importance of eliminating illegal, unreported, and unregulated (IUU) fishing activities for sustainable use of fishery resources. To this end, Japan has been conducting high seas boarding and inspection on fishing vessels in accordance with the conservation and management measures of North Pacific Fisheries Commission (NPFC) and Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission (WCPFC) in cooperation with relevant countries.

The Japanese fisheries inspection vessel “HOSHOMARU” is currently conducting patrol trip in the NPFC and WCPFC Convention Area in order to combat IUU fishing. During the voyage, HOSHOMARU will call at Hawaii for resupplying food and fuel.
